

LAY BRICKS ON THE BOTTOM OF THE EVAPORATOR

LAY THE BRICKS IN A STRETCHER BOND PATTERN
(BREAK THE JOINT)





LAY THE BRICKS FOR THE FIRST ROW OF THE REAR WALL

AN ANGLE CUT IS REQUIRED ON THE CORNER OF THE BRICKS TOWARDS THE EXTERIOR







DO THE FIRST ROW OF BRICKS ON THE OTHER SIDES



LAY THE BRICKS ON THE SIDE AND REAR WALLS.

CROSS THE BRICKS IN THE REAR CORNERS, SO THAT YOU DO NOT HAVE A JOINT.









THE LAST ROW IS DONE WITH THE SMALL BRICKS 1¼ X 4½ X 9 CUT TO NOT EXCEED THE HEIGHT OF THE EVAPORATOR



LET THE CEMENT DRY FOR A MINIMUM OF 48 HOURS AND THEN GENTLY PRE-COOK AT LOW HEAT FOR 3 HOURS BEFORE FIRST USE.
